8. 7/27/70. NE 1:33:C-6 Locus 33005 R 398
NE 1:33:13

Unclear, perhaps Jannaeus, time of the Civil War, Reifenberg No. 15a

This coin might, however, be of a different period. It needs further study.
The design is almost invisible.

9. 7/20/70. NE 1:33:C-1 Locus 33000 R 397
1:33:16

Unidentifiable for the present. No design visible. Probably late Roman.

10. 7/27/70. NE 1:33:C-3 Locus 33060 R 392
1:33:12

Dynasty of Constantine. Perhaps Constantius II, 337-361 AD

Obverse: Portrait of the ruler

Reverse: GLORIA EXERCITUS Two standards between two soldiers
