- 8. 7/27/70. NE 1:33:C-6 Locus 33005 R 398
 Unclear, perhaps Jannaeus, time of the Civil War, Reifenberg No. 15a
 This coin might, however, be of a different period. It needs further study. The design is almost invisible.
- 9. 7/20/70. NE 1:33:C-1 Locus 33000 R 397
 Unidentifiable for the present. No design visible. Probably late Roman.
- Dynasty of Constantine. Perhaps Constantius II, 337-361 AD
 Obverse: Portrait of the ruler
 Reverse: GLORIA EXERCITUS Two standards between two soldiers
