Dating: Probably Constantius II (337-361 AD)
May even be early Byzantine.

3/6/70. NW1:32:C.6 Locus 32.014

Obverse: Inscription illegible.
Bust of Emperor to right.
Reverse: VOT X MULT XX in wreath.
Dating: 4th or 5th century AD.
This coin needs further study.

3/10/70. NW1:32:C.11 Locus 32.001

Obverse: Lion walking to left.
Line of dots. Beneath Arabic inscription.
Reverse: Arabic inscription in three lines:
2nd line: Mohammed is the "Messenger of Allah"
Dating: Most probably (El Dhaher Roun el Din) Beibars
(AD 1260-1277)

Obverse: Bust of Emperor to right.
Reverse: Very poorly preserved. Extremely thin coin.
Dating: Probably 4th century AD

Jehouathan the High Priest (and the Council of Jews)
Reverse: Pair of Cornacopiae with pomegranate between
Dating: Alexander Jannaeus (ca. 104-95 BC)
