 Rev: V OT XX MVLIT XXX in wreath  
 Constantius II, 337-361 AD
- 84. 8/11/70. NW 1:30:C-27<sup>23</sup> L. 30012  
 Obv: Bust of Emperor to right.  
 Rev: Obliterated.  
 Seemingly Late Roman, 4th Century AD
- 85. 8/7/70. NE 1:34:C-2<sup>9</sup> L. 34001  
 Obv: Bust of Emperor to left, holding sceptre in right )(?)  
 IMPERATOR CONSTANTINVS AVG  
 Rev: Soldier standing left. SOLI INVICTI COMITI  
 In left field T R . Right: star.  
 In exergue: illegible.  
 Constantine I, Augustus AD 308-337.
- 86. 8/7/70. NW 1:32:C-9<sup>24</sup> Locus 32001  
 Obv: Lion walking to left.  
 Rev: "There is no God but Allah, Mohammed is the messenger of Allah"  
 Mameluke, probably 14th century AD
- 87. 8/10/70. NW 1:32:C-10<sup>25</sup> Locus 32001  
 Obv: Bust of Emperor to right  
 ( DN ) CONSTANTII -- VS ( PF AVG)  
 Rev: Standard between two soldiers, GLORIA EXERCITVS  
 Constantius II, Augustus 337-361 AD
